Important instructions


- Do not use the phone while driving.

Inserting the battery

Carefully remove the back cover of the phone. Insert the battery so that the contacts are facing down and touching the metal contacts in the phone'.





Inserting the SIM card (SIM1 / SIM2)

Remove the battery, if inserted, locate the SIM card slot and insert the SIM card with the metal contacts facing down.



Inserting a microSD memory card

Remove the battery, if inserted, locate the memory card slot (TF slot) and insert it with the metal contacts facing down.



CAUTION! Turn off the phone and disconnect the charger when handling the battery, memory card, or SIM card. Use only original batteries supplied by the phone manufacturer!

Charging the battery

1. Make sure the battery is inserted in the phone.

- 2. Connect the charger to the Type-C connector on the bottom of the phone.
- 3. Charging will start automatically.
- 4. The phone can be charged while it is turned on or off.
- 5. The battery charge status is indicated on the phone screen.

Turning the phone on and off

- 1. To turn on the phone, press and hold the button with the nd red handset. The welcome logo will appear on the display.
- 2. If required, enter the access password and confirm it with the confirmation button.
- 3. Enter the SIM card PIN if required and confirm with the confirmation button.
- 4. To turn off the phone, press and hold the button with the red handset.

After unlocking the SIM card, the phone will automatically search for an available network. After successful registration, the name of the operator will appear on the display.

Locking and unlocking the keypad

The keys are locked using the Menu and * keys. You can set automatic locking inthe menu / Settings / Security / Automatic keypad lock after a specified time. The keys are unlocked by pressing the Unlock... and * keys. The keys can also be locked and unlocked by pressing and holding *

Dialing a number

In the nd standby mode, enter the area code, if required, and the phone number using the phone

keypad and press the green handset button. This will dial the entered phone number. To end the call, press the red handset button. Volume – adjust during a call using the up/down navigation arrows. Hands-free mode – press the right function button during a call.

CAUTION!

The phone receiver may be loud. Therefore, do not set the volume to the highest level unnecessarily to avoid damage to your hearing. In addition, when the volume is set higher, the other party may hear an echo of their voice under certain circumstances. In such a case, reduce the volume until this phenomenon disappears.

Call log

To access the Call Log menu, select Menu / Call Log. Then press the OKbutton.

In the Call Log menu of the , the following options are available for the : Missed calls, Dialled numbers, Received calls, Rejected calls, Delete all, Call duration meters, Data service counter

Messages

The phone allows you to receive and send text messages (SMS). You will be notified of a new message by a symbol on the phone screen. To create a new SMS message, select: Menu/ Messages / Write message.

You can change the font size and insert various characters into the text using the # and * keys. When you have finished writing the text, select **Options / Send**. Enter the recipient's phone number or select from your contacts () and then confirm by **selecting Send**.

Received – contains received messages. You can view them using the up and down navigation buttons and open them using the middle function button.

The following options are also available the following options:

Write message; Received messages; Sent messages; Drafts; Sent messages; Templates; Send message; Voice mail server; Delete all; Settings; Message capacity.

Contact

The phone contains a contact directory where you can store names and phone numbers, either in the phone memory or on the SIM card. You can access your contacts via Menu / Contacts. You now have several options to choose from:

Contacts – displays a list of contacts (phone, SIM card, both), Add – create a new contact in the list (you can choose whether to save the contact to the phone or SIM 1/2 card), Delete all – delete all contacts stored in the phone/SIM card,

Import/Export – allows you to save/load contacts to/from internal storage or SD card. Contacts are saved as a ".vcf" file, **Speed dial** – with speed dial, you can easily dial your favorite numbers by holding down one of the keys on the keypad. You can now enable/disable and set speed dial for keys 2 to 9 **Memory status** – displays the number of contacts in device and free space

FM radio

To enter the FM radio menu, select Monu / FM radio and then press OK. Use the left function key (options) to call up the following options:

Automatic channel search and save, Channel list, Save, Manual search, Turn on speaker, Play in background. Helo Radio controls: On/off (middle

function key), Volume + / - (up and down arrows), Auto search + (right arrow), Auto search – (left arrow), Press the right function button (exit) to turn off FM Radio

Multimedia

To access the Multimedia menu, select Menu / Multimedia and then press OK. The following options are available in the Multimedia menu on the : Camera; Video Recorder; Audio Player; Video Player; Recording Device; Image Viewer; File Manager.

Camera

The camera lens is located on the back of the phone. To access the menu Camera menu, select Menu / Multimedia / Camera , then press OK. To take a picture (camera shutter), use the "middle function button." Use the up and down arrows to zoom in and out. In options tab, you can choose from: Image viewer; Video mode: Effect; Settings.

CAUTION! Capturing may take a few moments, so please remain still after pressing the shutter button. Otherwise, the image may be blurred.

Images can be saved to the phone's internal storage or to a memory card. We always recommend using a memory card to avoid filling up the internal storage.

Video recorder

To access the Video Recorder menu, select Menu / Multimedia / Video Recorder and then press OK. Themiddle function keyis used to record video (start recording). Use the up and down arrows to zoom in and out. In the , you can choose from the following

options: Show video directory, Photo mode, Effect, Settings.

File manager

To access the File Manager menu, select Menu / Multimedia / File Manager and then press OK. A simple file manager will open. Files can be viewed either by type (audio, images, video, documents) or by folder, similar to a computer (displays files and folders on the internal storage) and External storage (to view the contents of the MicroSD card, if inserted).

Alarm

To access the Alarm menu, select Menu / Alarm and then press OK. The phone is equipped with independent alarms, each of which can be set separately. The alarm can be set to repeat, specific days can be defined when it should ring, etc. Alarm settings:

Select one of the 3 available alarms, Set alarm – Active / OK, Time: set as desired, Ringtone – select one of the preset ringtones or choose your own using Next ringtone, Repeat mode – select one of the 3 options (once, every day, weekly), press the right function key to return, which saves and activates the alarm

Calendar

To enter the menu Calendar menu, select Menu / Applications / Calendar then press OK. The calendar allows you to view and browse the calendar and add events with reminders for each day. Setting reminders: Calendar / Options / Add task Here you can set everything you need and save it. This will save the task for the civen day.

Calculator:

To access the Calculator menu, select Menu / Applications / Calculator and then press OK. The phone includes a simple and practical calculator with basic functions.

Control

Use the keypad to enter numbers, Delete – right function key, Decimal point is entered by pressing the * key, Use the up/down arrows to select the desired operation +, -, I, x. Exit the calculator by pressing the key with the red handset.

Bluetooth

To access the **Bluetooth** menu, select **Menu** / **Applications** / **Bluetooth** and then press **OK**.

Bluetooth is a modern system that allows you to connect various devices wirelessly, e.g. a wireless hands-free kit and a phone, a phone and a computer, or two phones with each other. You can transfer call audio or send files or receive files from another device

The the following menu is available:

Bluetooth Active / Off; Bluetooth visibility; Paired devices; File transfer; My Bluetooth name; Bluetooth file storage; Address information; Help

Profiles

The phone allows you to set profiles which can be found in Menu / Settings / Profiles. Here you can set the ringtone and SMS tone, vibration, ringtone type, ringtone and SMS volume, keyboard sound and volume, the tone when turning the phone on and off,

and the sound of the 12 system tones. After selecting the appropriate profile, you have the following options: Activate (activate the selected profile), Rename, Ringtone settings, Adjust volume, Ringtone type. Other alert tones

SOS Locator – emergency call, SMS and location determination function

Your phone is equipped with a special SOS button. When pressed, the phone automatically calls a preset number and sends the phone's location to that number via SMS in the form of a link to be displayed on a map — if the recipient uses a standard phone with an Internet browser, they simply click on the link to display a map showing the phone's location.

Service settings

For the service to work properly, you must first activate it and set the number that the phone will call and send an SMS to when the SOS button is pressed. To access the SOS settings , select Menu / Settings / SOS settings , then press OK.
SOS status – Active, SOS numbers – manual editing or adding from contacts, SOS SMS – On/Off, SOS SMS – SOS SMS text, Alert tone status – Active

Making an emergency call and sending an SMS

Press and hold the SOS button on the back of the phone. When SOS is activated, the phone first counts down 5 seconds and then calls and sends an SMS 5 times in a row. During this cycle, SOS can be canceled by holding down the SOS button.

Alternatively, during the countdown, the emergency call can be terminated by pressing the right function button Cancel. An emergency message containing a link to the phone's location on a map is then sent to

the preset number, and the phone will attempt to call that number

Location determination function

The location sent in the SMS link is determined based on the operator's network, with accuracy depending on network density in the given location. For example, in cities, the location can be determined with an accuracy of tens to a few hundred meters, but outside built-up areas, the accuracy generally decreases.

GSM Locator

The GSM Locator service allows you to track the location of your mobile phone by sending an SMS message in the form of SOS123 from another mobile phone. The phone will then send a link to Google Maps with the approximate location of your mobile phone. The phone will also send the location if the SOS mode has been activated (by pressing the SOS button).

This service is provided without any warranty, at the user's own risk, and the accuracy of the results or availability of the service is not guaranteed by the phone manufacturer, operator, or map provider.

Settings

To access the Settings menu , select Menu / Settings and thenpress OK. To set the basic properties, select Settings / Phone settings in the main menu of the phone. You now have several setting options: Time and date, Language settings, Automatic power on and off, Wallpaper settings, Contrast, Backlight, Keypad backlight time

The the following menu is available:

Profiles, Call settings, Phone settings, SOS settings, Security, Speech settings, Connect, Reset settings (password 0000)

Connecting to a computer

The phone is equipped with a standard Type-C connector, which is used for both charging and connecting to a personal computer.

Requires Windows 2000, XP, Vista, 7 or higher. If you are using a different operating system, you may need to use special drivers.

Transferring files between your phone and PC

If you want to transfer files to/from your phone, connect your phone to your computer using a Type-C cable (not necessarily included) and select "Mass storage." You can now use your computer to access the storage on your phone and transfer files between your computer and phone.

Other connection modes

If you want the phone to only charge when connected to a computer, press the left function button **OK**after connecting the cable.

Your phone may differ from the instructions at due to different software versions. Some menu items may not have a Czech translation for technical reasons. If the actual status of your phone does not correspond exactly to the instructions, follow the actual situation on your phone.
